1. Education and experience a tutor

4. The tutor works at the school

School teacher-tutor may not be the best choice, his experience with a team of students does not always work on individual lessons. However, ongoing work by the teachers at the school allows him to be aware of innovations, changes in programs.

5. Tutor conducts classes in one discipline

The competence of a specialist in several disciplines, as a rule, lower in most questions. Even the combination of homogeneous subjects is not always the best.

6. A true professional does not build forecasts at the first lesson

Only detailed observation of the child is given the opportunity to make plans and to make specific predictions.

7. A good tutor gives complete information about yourself

He will tell you about the types of assistance provided, what children prefer to work.

8. The appearance of the tutor is sympathetic

Even if the teacher has seven spans in a forehead, but causes negative emotions, his work is useless. Feature of child psychology is the relationship between the individual teachers and their subjects.

9. The results of the first classes

An experienced tutor will inquire about the psychological characteristics of the child, mode of his day, interests, and aptitudes.

10. Neither coach does not guarantee for the unified state exam (EIT)

A good tutor will make every effort to do so.
